THE WORLD OF HORIZON

A thousand years after a global cataclysm, Earth has been remade into a lush, thriving ecosystem, but with a new dominant species: the machines. These massive, animal-like robots fill the lands, oceans and skies, serving as the guardians and enforcers of the revived natural order.

Millions of fans have fought against, destroyed and defeated machines in Horizon Zero Dawn and now Horizon Forbidden West. But what is it like to build one?

THE MACHINES

The people of Horizon look upon the machines with wonder and awe. Overall, they appear to be the preservers and protectors of the natural world. Humans live with them in an uneasy balance – hunting some for metal and ammunition, fighting others that encroach on settlements. But a few of these metal giants are so majestic and powerful that no one dares go near them.





THE TALLNECK

Oblivious to interruption and impervious to attack, these giants circle wide areas, monitoring local conditions. Their massive, disk-like heads contain communication hubs that send out signals to other machines. While completely peaceful, they are often guarded by packs of sentries and combat units.

This display model showcases the beautiful and dangerous world of Horizon with the majestic Tallneck, a vigilant Watcher and Aloy.

Disk: New building techniques formed the clean circle shape and a solid structure. It is the most complex assembly of the set (and the most fun!).

Neck: The basic armour plate pattern is almost identical to our first LEGO® sketch model. The neck structure, however, was significantly altered to mimic the mechanical details.

Body and legs: Sideways building captures the right angles and curves.

Feet: Carefully designed to get the right shape, the feet also connect well with the base.

Display base: Includes tall grass where Aloy can hide to avoid the Watcher.
